Then, take a “Freccia Rossa” or “Freccia Argento” train (<https://www.trenitalia.com/en>), or “Italo” (<https://www.italotreno.it/en>) train to Padua (approx 40 EUR/pax one way, 2 hours journey, direct train)
- From Milano Linate airport:
 - o take a taxi (<https://milanoradiotaxi.it/>) or a shuttle bus to Milano Centrale (5 EUR, 25’ minutes journey).
