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WP2: Building tools - Goals

1. to connect between academics from interdisciplinary fields, field innovators and entrepreneurs and experts from the mainstream financial industry;
2. to establish framework for acceptable tools to promote knowledge exchange between industry, academia and government;
3. to localize SF through learning from others' experiences;
4. to build online open-access case studies platform

WP2: Building tools - Tasks

T 2.1 Establish framework and guidelines - best cases collection, studying and simulation practices (using advanced technology, digital & interactive case-study format)

T 2.2 Create open source case studies portal - strategic planning and definitions of the portal and project website digital platforms

T 2.3 Face the Case - Students, faculty and practitioners' visits to field partners in Israel and Europe (students will participate in study tours in Israel only)

T 2.1 Establish framework and guidelines

Following WP1 results:

4-day workshop will be held in UniPD (Italy) to establish a framework for knowledge exchange [May 2021].

Day1: present relevant information to create standardizations for case studies collection to support knowledge sharing

Day2: international case studies (presentations by EU partners)

Day3: new teaching methods for case study delivery

Day4: small group discussions

T 2.2 Create open source case studies portal

Following T1.2 SF framework scheme:

Develop a specification report for a case studies portal [May 2021].

Detailed analysis of the needs, requirements, constraints and priorities of prospective users in the partner institutions, especially relating to case studies teaching and simulation.

Design and develop the web-based portal, including layout, user interface and graphic design, backend database design, and reporting system design.

Maintain the portal throughout the project lifetime.

T 2.3 Face the Case: visits to field partners

Visits of faculty to Impact Hubs and social technology hubs.

2 study visits will be held in EU partner universities: EUR (NL) [July 2021] and HUEI (DE) [March 2022].

At least 4 industrial and academic visits of faculty and students in Israel (full day) consist of 5 sessions: organizational introduction and visions, current needs and challenges facing the organization and their field of operation, technological and design interfaces of SF content, regulation, discussions on SF practices and perspectives and joint initiatives that might be implemented [July 2021-October 2022].
